

**Subject: UPLOADING OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS AND PUBLICATION OF
BID EVALUATION REPORTS ON PPRA WEBSITE**

1. Uploading of bidding documents on the Authority's Website:

Pursuant to the Rule 12 read with Rule 23 of Public Procurement Rules 2004, all procuring agencies are required to upload complete set of bidding documents on the website of Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) i.e. www.ppra.gov.pk, immediately after the publication of Invitation to Bids. The procuring agencies shall neither distribute printed copies of the bidding documents nor charge any fee for the issuing bidding documents. In order to ensure equal opportunity and non-discrimination among bidders, the procuring agency shall allow all prospective bidders to access and use bidding documents through PPRA website and e-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS).

Where a procurement advertisement is also published in newspaper(s), the procuring agency shall ensure that the corresponding URL(s) of the newspaper publication is also provided at PPRA website at the time of uploading Invitation to Bids.

2. Announcement of evaluation reports on PPRA Website and EPADS:

Pursuant to Rule 35 of Public Procurement Rules 2004, the announcement of the results of the bid evaluation report means publication of technical evaluation report and final evaluation report, as the case may be, on the PPRA's website i.e. www.ppra.gov.pk, giving justification for acceptance or rejection of bids.

The standstill period for grievance redressal shall be calculated from the publication of evaluation report(s) on the PPRA website.
