**APPEAL UNDER RULE 48 (7) OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES, 2004 AGAINST THE IMPUGNED DECISION OF TECHNICAL EVALUATION COMMITTEE DATED 25-03-2026 AND GRC / RESPONDENT NO. 2**

The Authority received an Appeal on 13-04-2026 under Rule 48(7) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004, filed by M/s ALPHA EXIMP (Pvt) Ltd. through its Chief Executive Officer Mian Muhammad Farhan. The Authority on receipt of the Appeal issued notices on 14-04-2026 to M/s ALPHA EXIMP (Pvt.) Ltd. *through its Chief Executive Officer Mian Muhammad Farhan* ("Appellant"); Oil & Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL), *through its Technical Evaluation Committee*; Oil & Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL), *through its Chairman Grievance Redressal*

Committee; and Oil & Gas Development Company Limited (OGDCL), through its Chief Executive Officer ("Respondent(s)"), wherein it was directed to appear in person or through their nominated representatives or Counsel before the Authority on 29-04-2026 before the Appellate Committee in the Committee Room of Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA). The present appeal was registered as Appeal No. PPRA/AP-20/2026.

2. On the said date of hearing i.e., 29.04.2026, the above-mentioned representatives of the parties appeared before the Committee and presented their arguments. At the first hearing, the Respondents (OGDCL) apprised the Appellate Committee that the process for re-evaluation of the subject tender is currently underway and sought an adjournment of the appeal proceedings. Upon the said request, the Appellant has raised no objection. The Appellate Committee, having taken cognizance of the statement made by the Respondents, and adjourned the matter accordingly.


3. Thereafter, the Authority has received a written application dated 14-05-2026 submitted by the Appellant seeking withdrawal of the above-captioned Appeal. In the said application, the Appellant has submitted that the instant Appeal is presently pending adjudication before the Appellate Committee. Further, the Respondents have completed the revised evaluation process and declared the Appellant as responsive and the revised evaluation report issued by the Evaluation Committee has been

made part of the tender record and uploaded on the Respondents' official website. It has also been stated that the process for issuance of the Letter of Intent (LOI) has commenced. Moreover, the Appellant has submitted that the instant appeal has become infructuous and has accordingly prayed for permission to withdraw the instant Appeal in the interest of justice.


