APPEAL UNDER RULE 48(7) OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES, 2004

The above-mentioned learned counsel appeared on behalf of the Respondent (GEPCO) on the date of hearing fixed.

2. Through this instant Appeal, the Appellant(s) i.e., M/s GMR (Joint Venture), challenged the conditions of the tender No. 5681-82 for the lease of Chicho ki Mallian P.C Pole Plant dated 24.04.2024, the corrigendum dated 28.06.2024

and the decision of Board of Directors, GEPCO (the Respondent) dated 12.08.2024.

3. It is relevant to mention here that M/s RK Constructors (Pvt.) Ltd. through a letter dated 15.01.2025 requested the Appellate Committee (the Committee) to include their firm in the instant Appeal as a necessary party, being most advantageous bidder in tender called in question. Therefore, the Authority issued a Pre-Admission notice to M/s RK Constructors (Pvt.) Ltd. to provide an opportunity of hearing in the best interest of justice.

4. On the other hand, Gujranwala Electric Power Company, (GEPCO / the Respondent) filed its reply / para-wise comments in the instant Appeal on 31.01.2025.

5. Meanwhile, on the day of hearing i.e., 03.02.2025 the Appellant filed an application for withdrawal of tilted Appeal and submitted that as the impugned tender has been scrapped / cancelled by the competent authority i.e., GEPCO / the Respondent through a Notification No.8287-93 dated 21.01.2025.

6. In light of the above, the Committee observed that the grievance of the Appellant does not exist anymore as the tender called in question has already been scrapped by the Respondent. Therefore, the application dated 03.02.2025 filed

by the Appellant is **allowed**, and the Appeal in hand is hereby
dismissed being infructuous and disposed of accordingly.
