APPEAL UNDER RULE 48(7) OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES, 2004
[AGAINST TENDER NO.F-250750669 FOR IMPROVEMENT / UP-GRADATION / REHABILITATION OF ROAD LIGHT SYSTEM AT SRINAGAR HIGHWAY FROM ZEROPOINT SECTOR G-8 TO SECTOR G-12, ISLAMABAD, AND TENDER NO.F-250750654 FOR PROVIDING REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING 120WATT LED LIGHTS WITH HIGH LUMENS 180WATT LIGHTS AT SRINAGAR HIGHWAY FROM MUST GATE TO N-5 AND M1/M2 INTERCHANGE TO NEW AIRPORT, ISLAMABAD]

The Appellant i.e., Technoflux (Pvt.) Limited filed an appeal dated 18.09.2025 before the Authority under Rule 48(7) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 ("PP Rules") against the Capital Development Authority (CDA / the respondent) regarding the subject procurement processes.
