TENDER NO. NCB-256**


The above mentioned learned counsel(s) of the parties

2. The Appellant i.e., M/s Alamdar Engineering (Pvt.) Limited has filed the instant Appeal under Rule 48(7) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 ("PP Rules") against the impugned order of the Grievance Redressal Committee (the "GRC") dated **27.10.2025** and the Technical Evaluation Report ("TER") dated **16.10.2025** in Tender No. IESCO/PMU/NCB-256/2025-26 for procurement of 220kV EA Towers without Stubs and Cleats.

3. It is relevant to mention here that an Application under Order I, Rule 10 of the Code of Civil Procedure 1908 was filed by counsel of M/s Specialists Group Inc. Limited ("SGI") dated 13.11.2025, who was declared the responsive bidder as per the Summary of Technical Bid Evaluation Report dated 16.10.2025 in the abovementioned tender. Through the said application dated 1.11.2025, M/s SGI for impleadment of their firm as a necessary / proper party as respondent no.4.

4. At the very outset, learned counsel of the appellant submitted an application for withdrawal of the instant Appeal and stated that the parties reached at conclusion and settled the matter outside the forum, therefore, they do not want to pursue the case.

5. On the other hand, no objection was raised by the learned counsel of the respondent on the above referred application submitted by the appellant on the day of hearing.



6. In light of the above, the Appellate Committee allowed the application dated 19.11.2025 filed by the counsel of the appellant, therefore, the appeal in hand is hereby **dismissed being withdrawn** and disposed of accordingly.
