**APPEAL UNDER RULE 48(7) OF THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT RULES, 2004**

The Authority received an Appeal filed by M/s Impact Enterprises (Pvt) Limited, through its authorised representative Mr. Ali Akbar (Director Operations) on 28.04.2026 under Rule 48(7) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004. The Authority on receipt of the Appeal issued notices to M/s Impact Enterprises (Pvt) Limited, ("Appellant"); Pakistan Sports Board, through its Director General ("the Respondent"), wherein it was directed to appear in person or through their nominated representatives or Counsel before the Appellate Committee of the Authority on 15.07.2026.

2. On the scheduled date of hearing, i.e., 15.07.2026, the above-mentioned learned counsel and representative of the parties appeared before the Appellate Committee. On the

said date of hearing, the Appellate Committee has received a written application dated 15.07.2026 from the Appellant, i.e., M/s Impact Enterprises (Pvt) Limited, seeking withdrawal of the above-captioned appeal. In the said application, the Appellant has submitted that, upon due consideration and deliberation, it has voluntarily resolved to withdraw the instant appeal. The Appellant has further averred that the withdrawal is being made of its own free will and volition and shall be without prejudice to any rights, claims, remedies, or legal recourse that may be available to it under the applicable law, all of which are expressly reserved.

3. In view of the foregoing and the request made by the Appellant, and there being no objection on record to the proposed withdrawal, the Appellate Committee finds no legal impediment to permitting the withdrawal of the instant appeal. Accordingly, Appeal No. PPRA/AP-25/2026 is hereby ***dismissed as withdrawn.***
